

You may have heard me tell about some in-depth conversations I've had recently on different days with guys that I had just met. One looked at homosexuality as not being sinful. Another found himself attracted to prayers offered to Allah. The concept of absolute truth was either not understood or not accepted by either guy. Despite being "leaders" in their own "Christian" churches, neither of them had a depth of understanding about God's Word that many of our first-graders have.

Sadly, I suspect these guys were more the norm than not. It should not come as a surprise to any of us that there is a war against the Bible and it's truth. Satan always seems to start his work of deception by asking, "Has God said...?"

I hope you realize that the evil one seeks **not only** to keep unbelievers in the dark, but he also desires to lead **you** further from the Truth. Matthew 24:4 says, "See to it that no one misleads you." Ephesians 5:6 says, "Let no one deceive you." Similar thoughts are expressed in Gal. 6:7, 1 Cor. 6:9, and James 1:16. If God has to remind us that often....in fact, **He commands** us to not be deceived, then you know it's a real danger.

The danger starts with a shallow understanding of or appreciation for the Word of God. Knowing that the Word of God is a "light to our path" is key. To move away from the light is to move toward the darkness. Paul reminds us in his first chapter to the Romans that there are those who "suppress the truth by their wickedness." The refusal to embrace truth only leads to further deception. Hearts can become darkened—even among Christians.

While it's good for us to engage in respectful dialogue and discussions with people of all backgrounds, we cannot give ground on the truth of God's Word. In fact, it is through the hearing of that Word that faith is begun! (Romans 10:17) This broken world desperately needs what we have been freely given. So, I encourage you to strike up a conversation or two with anyone. Get to know a new person, and help them to know the Truth that will set them free! I'd love to help you in any way as you take on such an exciting adventure. Let's talk...to each other...and to anyone and everyone. We've got great stuff to share!




